When they got the phone call before Christmas, the news didn’t really register. “I was kind of shocked,” said Stormy. “I really didn’t think it would happen. I was in shock for a bit and still didn’t really believe it. It didn’t really sink in until we did our sweat equity hours and went and picked out our colors. I think that’s when it really hit us.”
